

Paper Procurement Policy

Established April 25, 2013

Revised September 15, 2026

Nikon shall procure paper with due consideration for biodiversity conservation and the sustainable use of forest resources.

【Applicable Materials】

The policy applies to the paper that the Nikon Group procures for its own business operations. This includes but is not limited to the following:

- Office-related paper such as copy paper, business cards, and corporate envelopes
- Paper used for product catalogs, instruction manuals, and product packaging
- Paper used for promotional materials such as boards, fixtures, and POP displays

【Operational Policy】

1. We shall confirm compliance with applicable laws and regulations. In particular, we shall confirm that logging procedures have been properly carried out in accordance with forest-related laws and regulations in the country or region where the timber is produced.

2. We shall not purchase paper products produced by companies that are deemed to have environmental or social issues in their raw material procurement or business activities.
3. When procuring paper, we shall prioritize purchasing FSC-certified paper or recycled paper.
4. If paper that meets the requirements of item 3 above is not available, we shall purchase paper that is certified under a reliable third-party certification scheme or complies with national or regional procurement policies^{*1}, provided that it is not sourced from areas of High Conservation Value (HCV).^{*2}

5. Any revision or abolition of this policy shall be deliberated by the Environmental Subcommittee and approved by the Chair of the Subcommittee.
